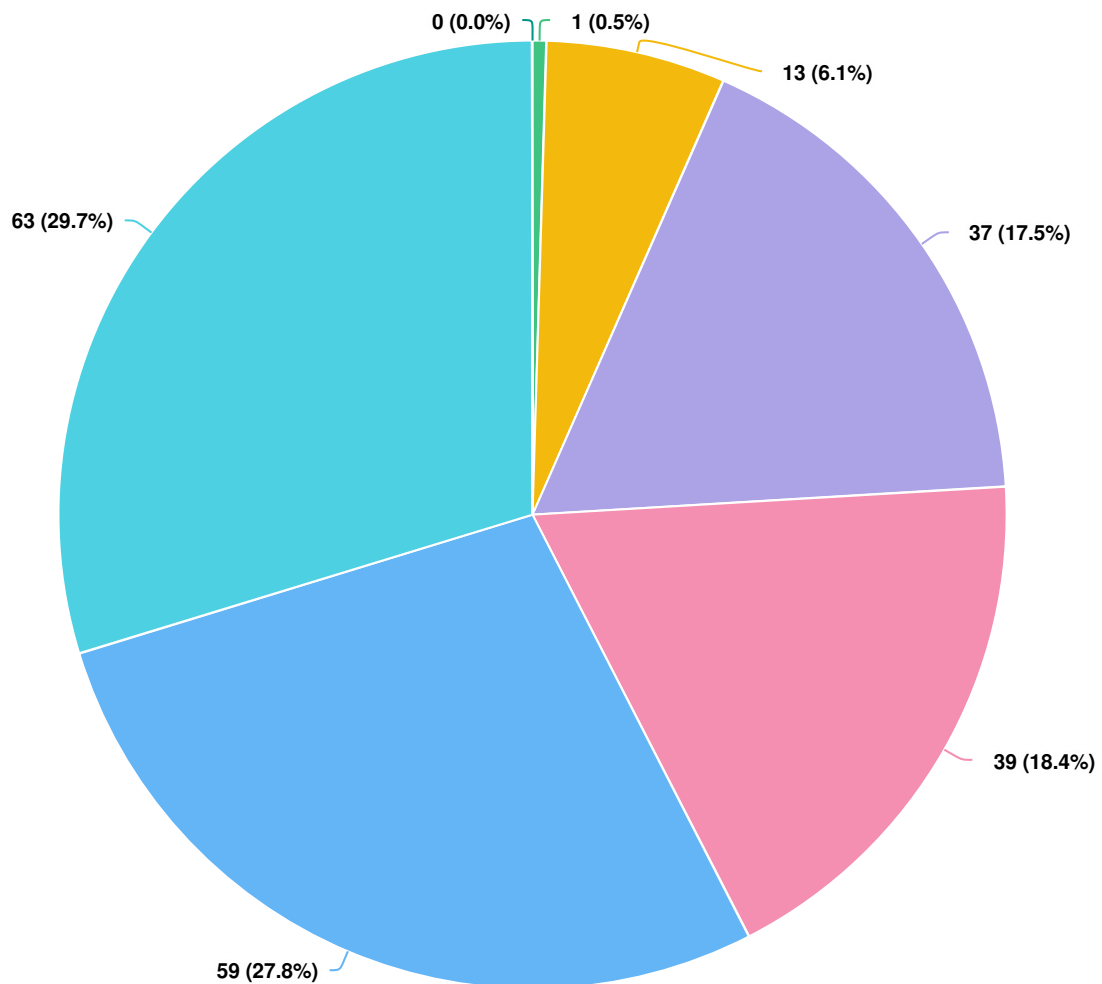

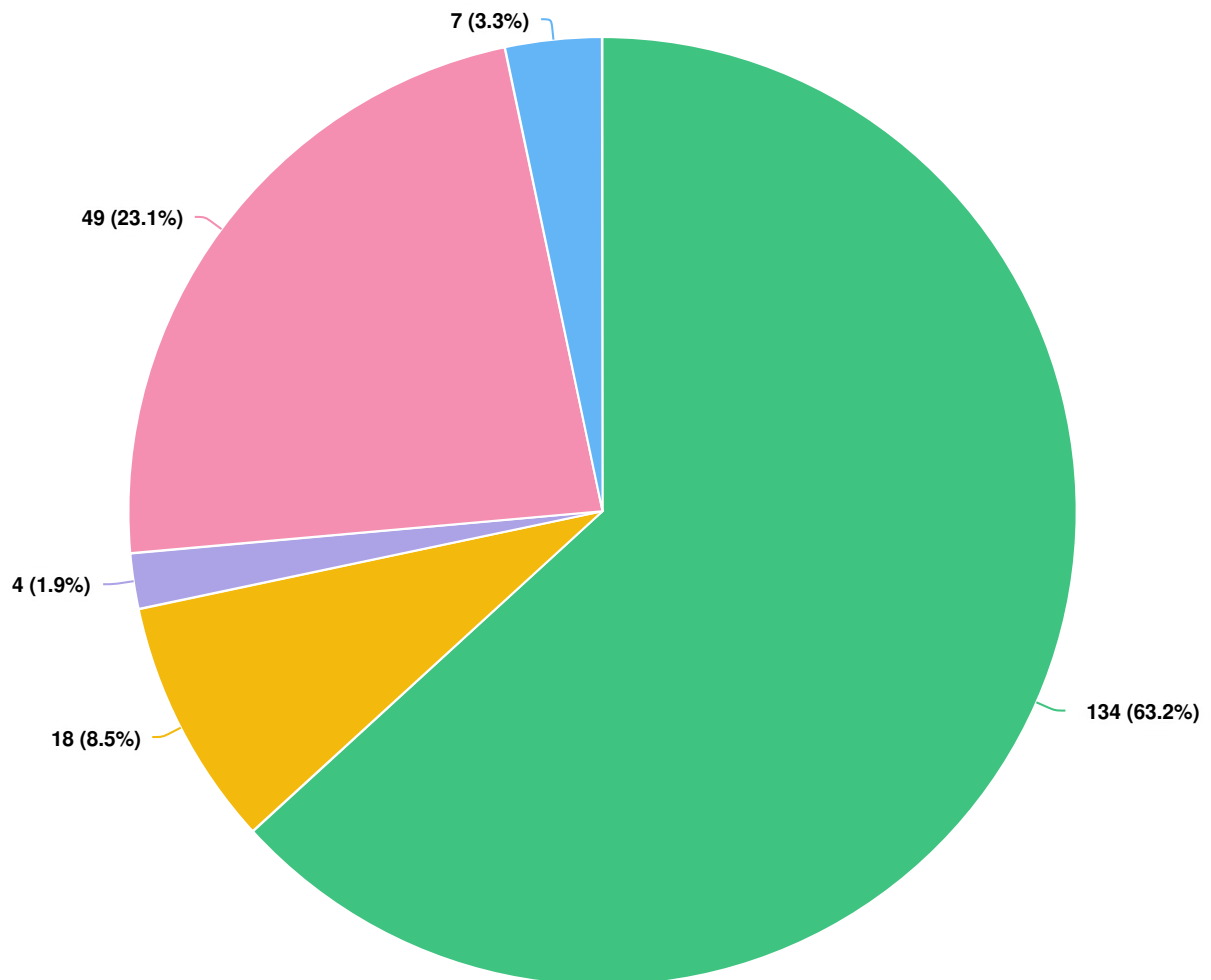

Q7 In what areas should short-term rentals be permitted?



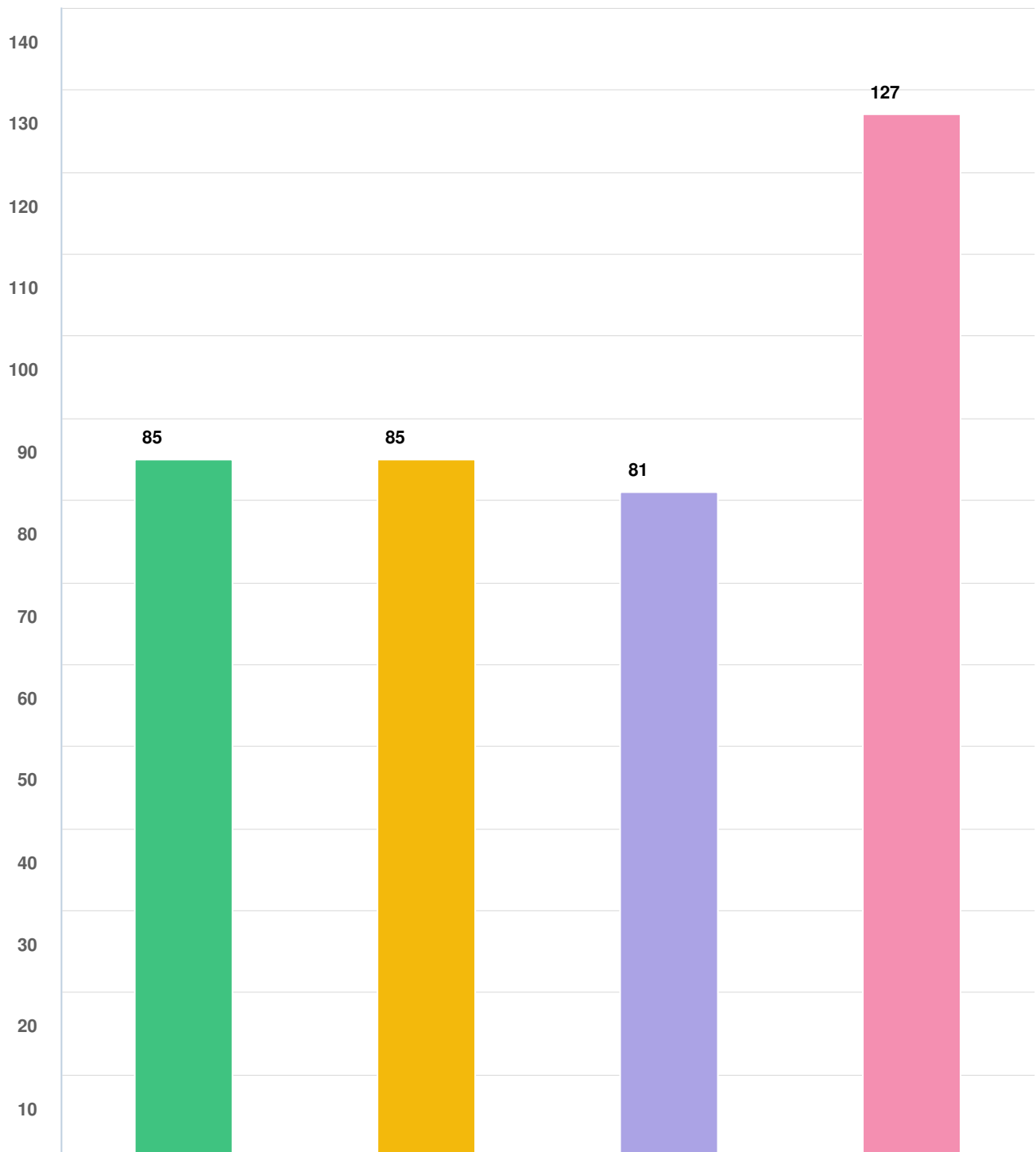

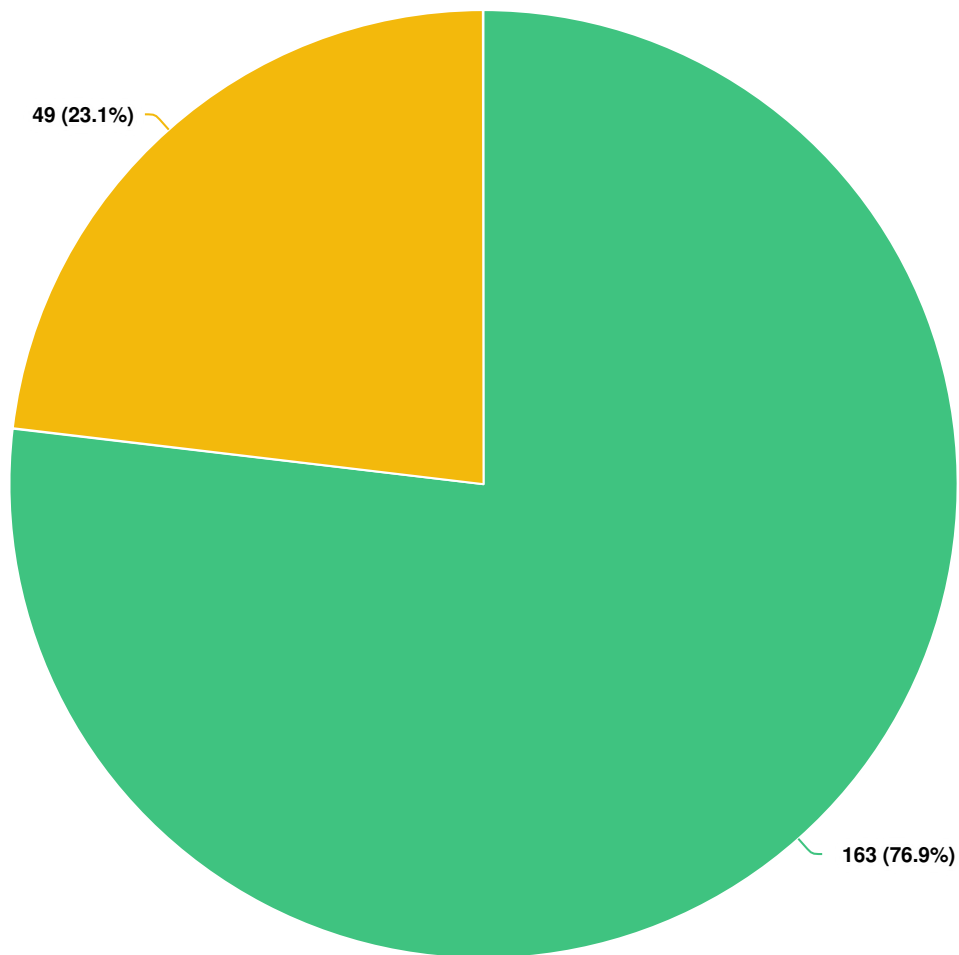

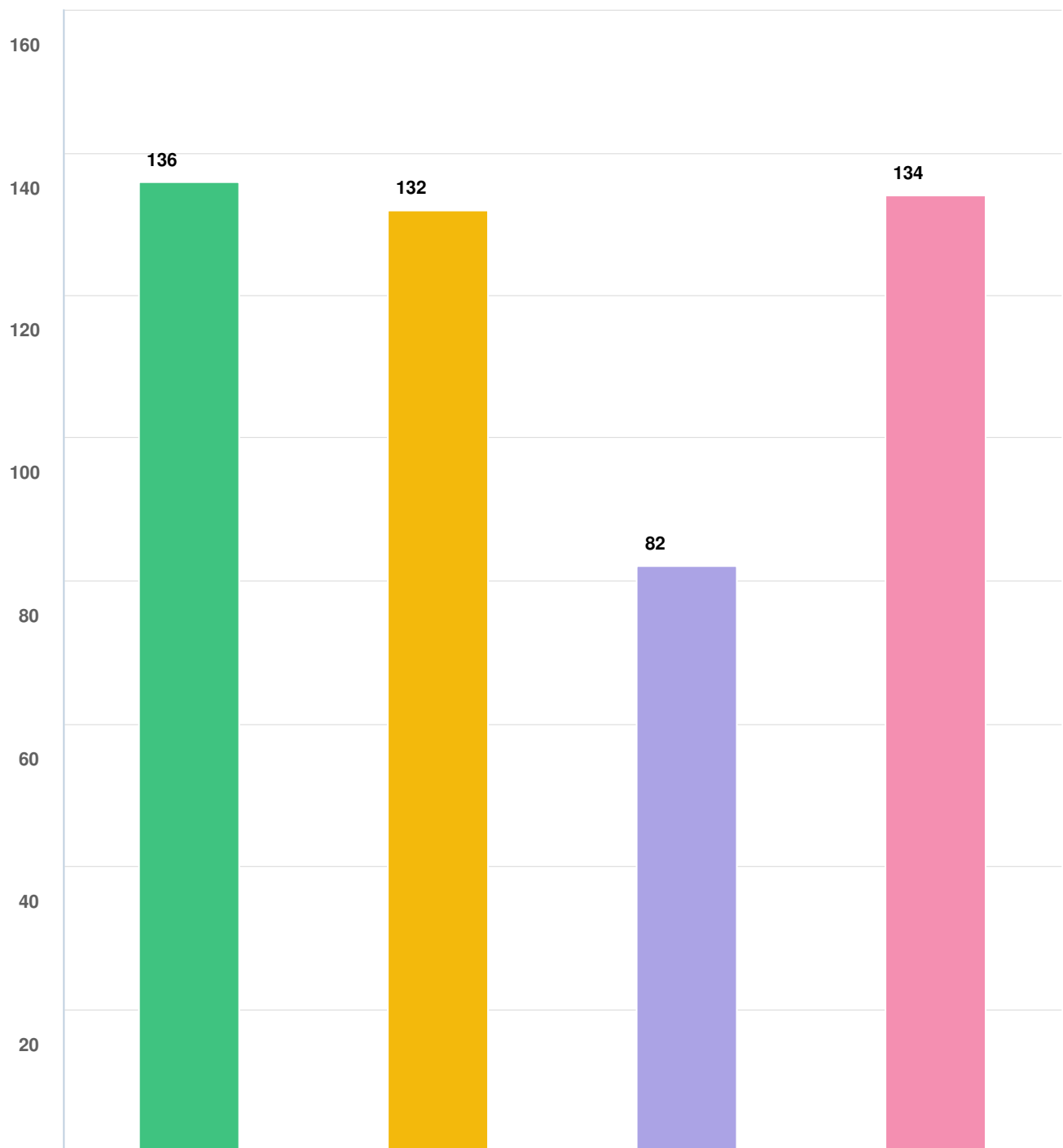

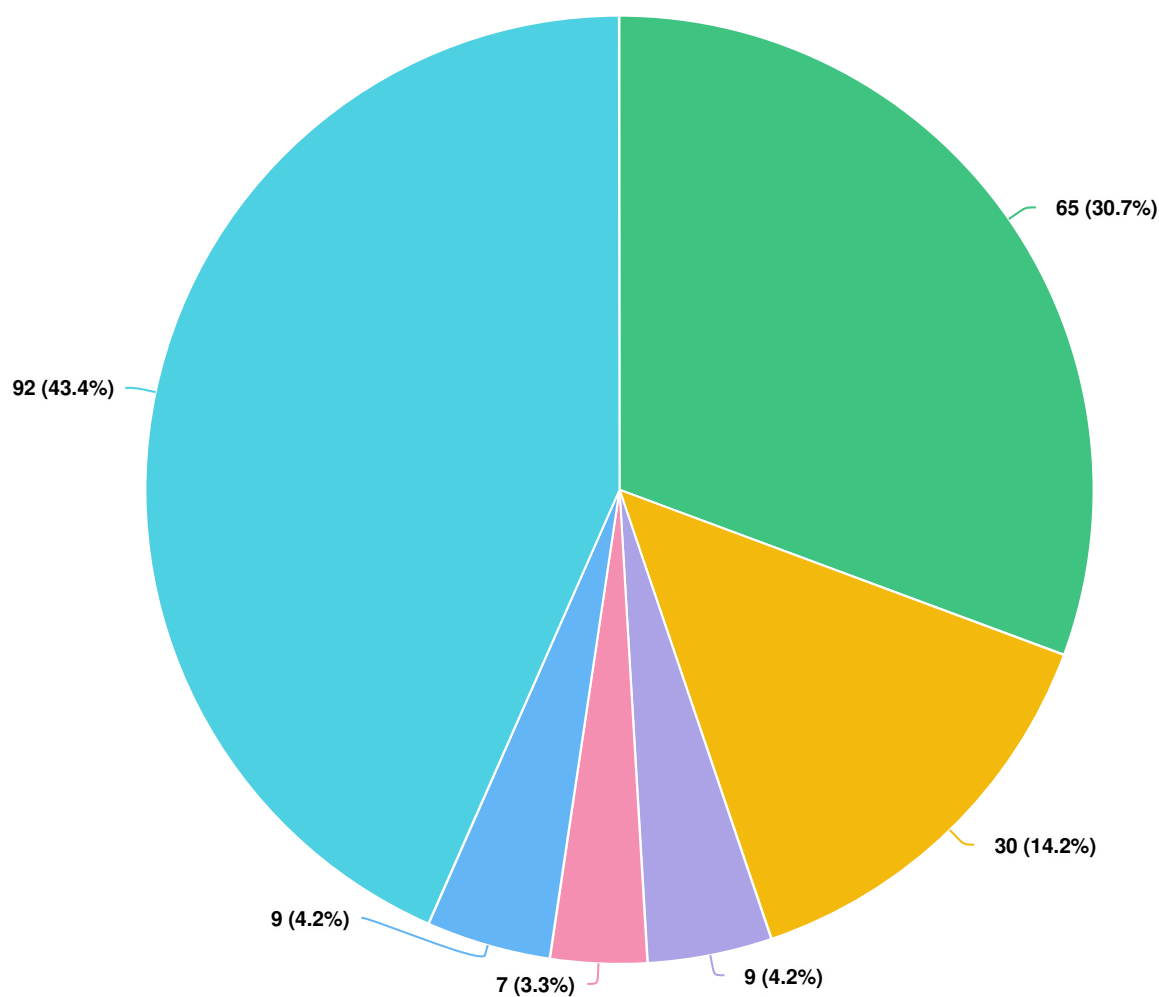

Q11 Should there be a limit on the TOTAL number of nights per year a short-term rental can be rented? This is referring to the total number of nights, not the length of stay for one rental period.

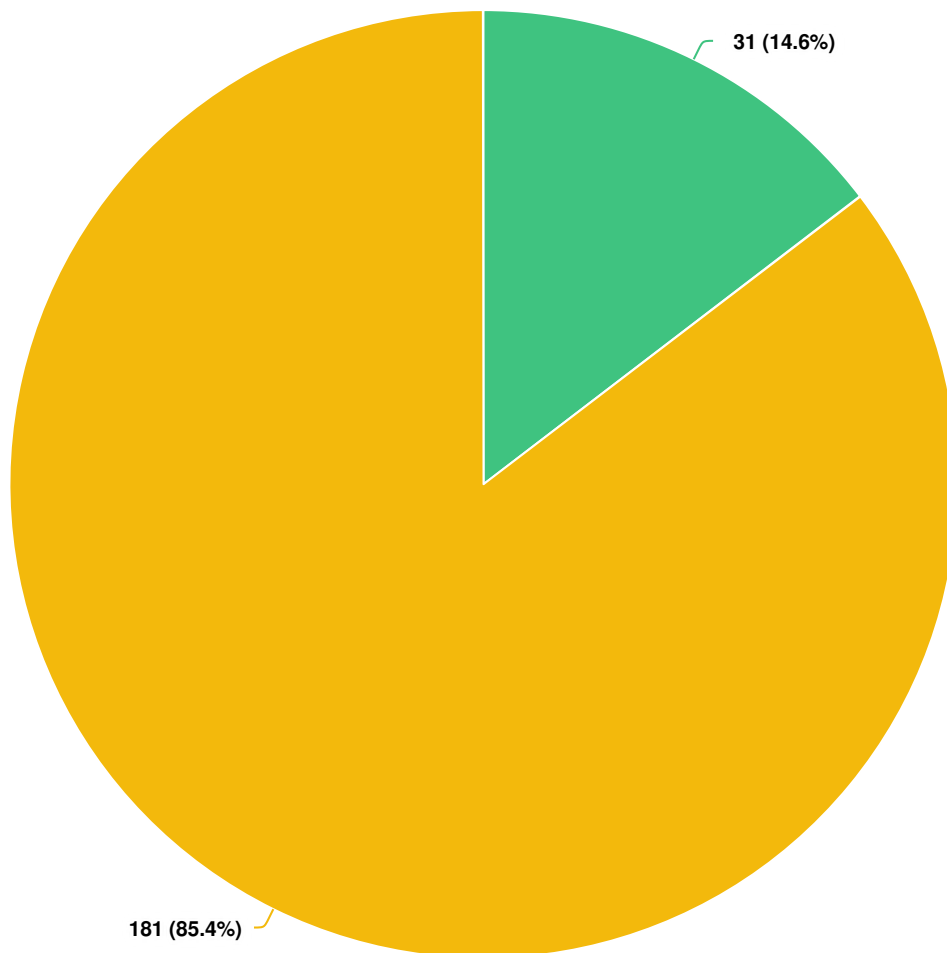

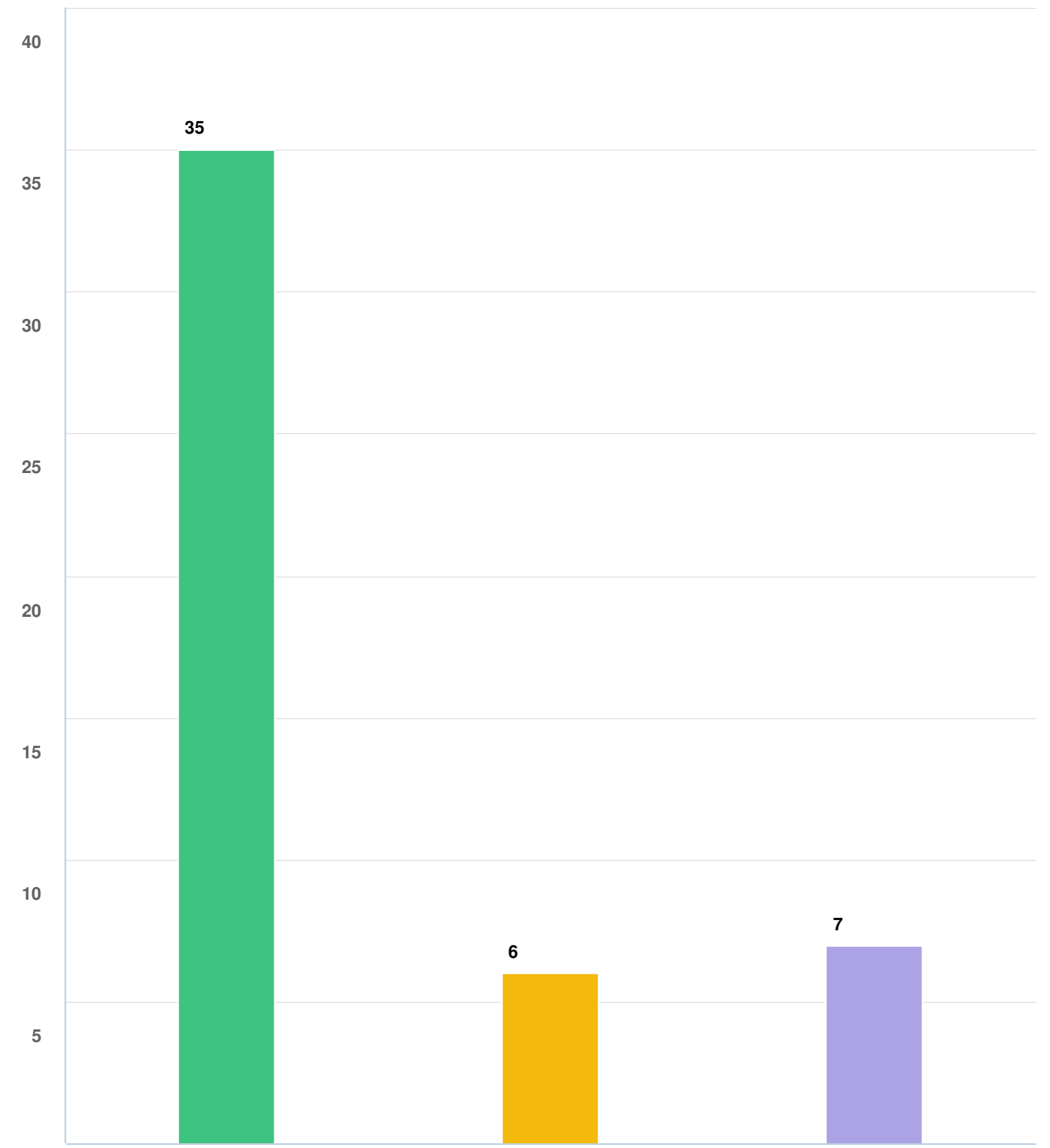

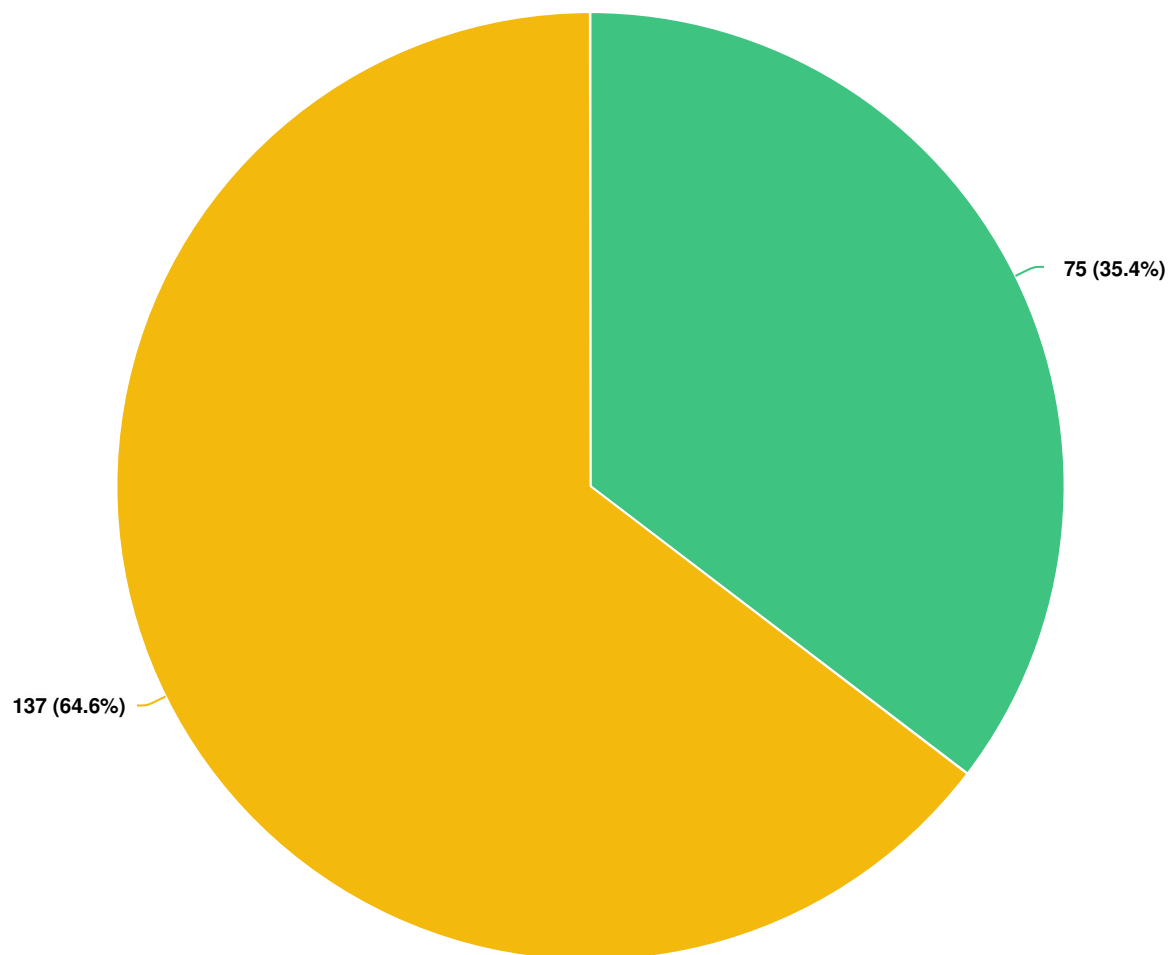

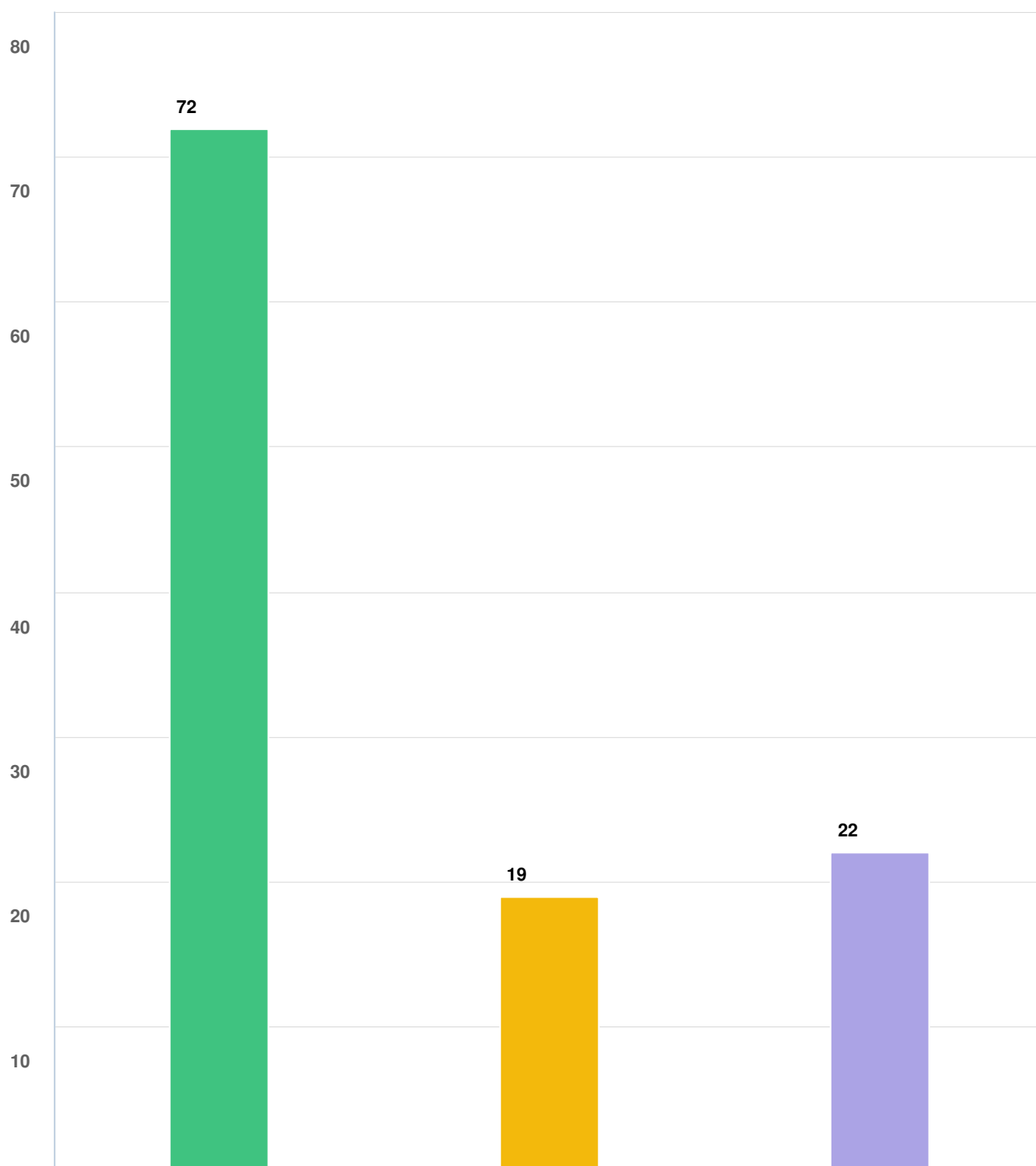

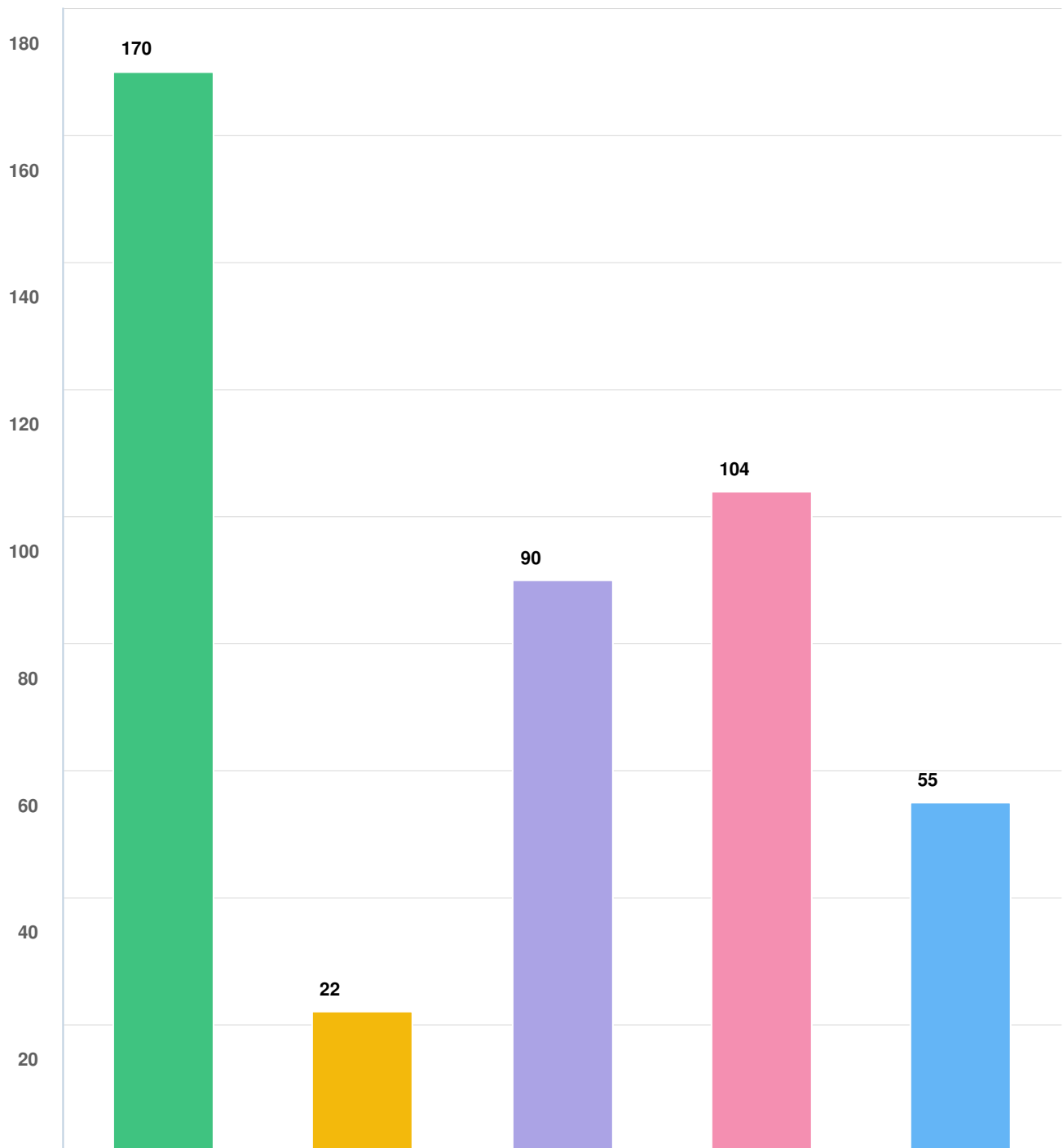

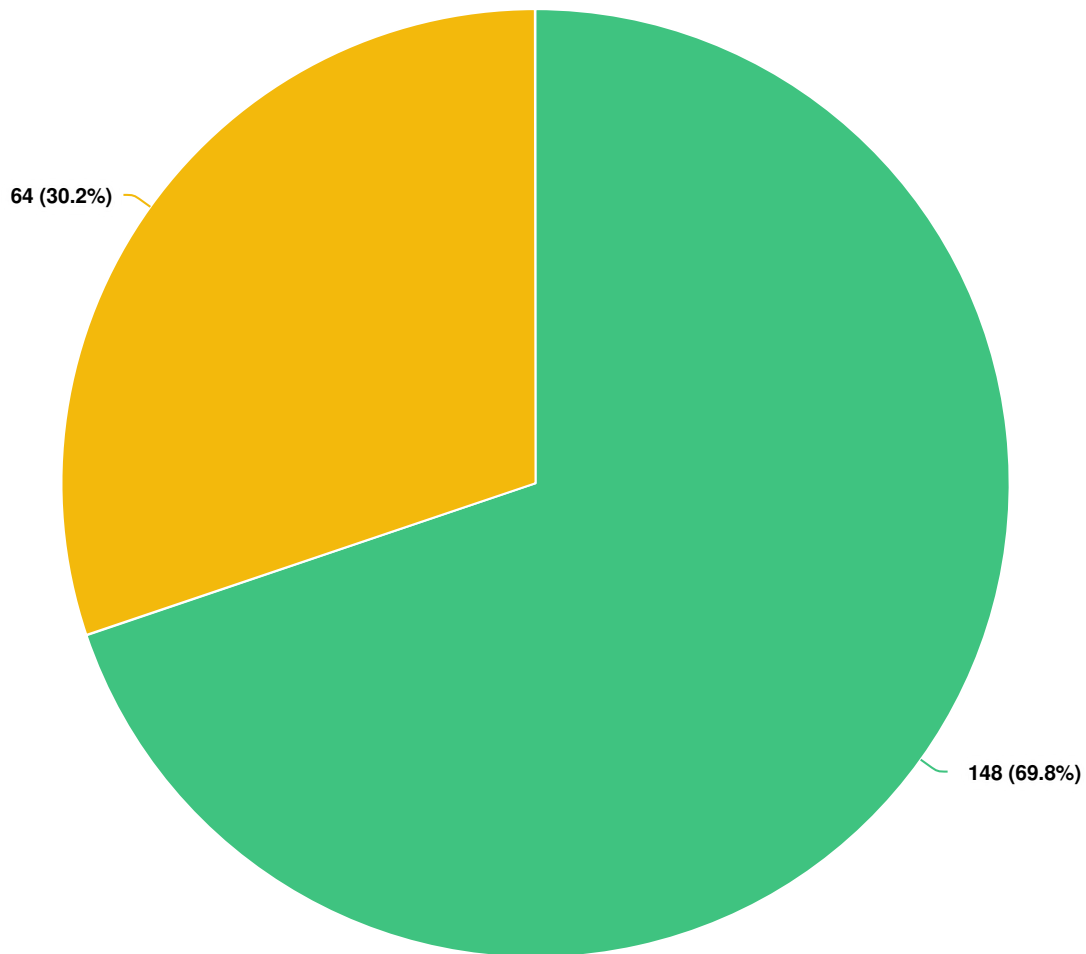
