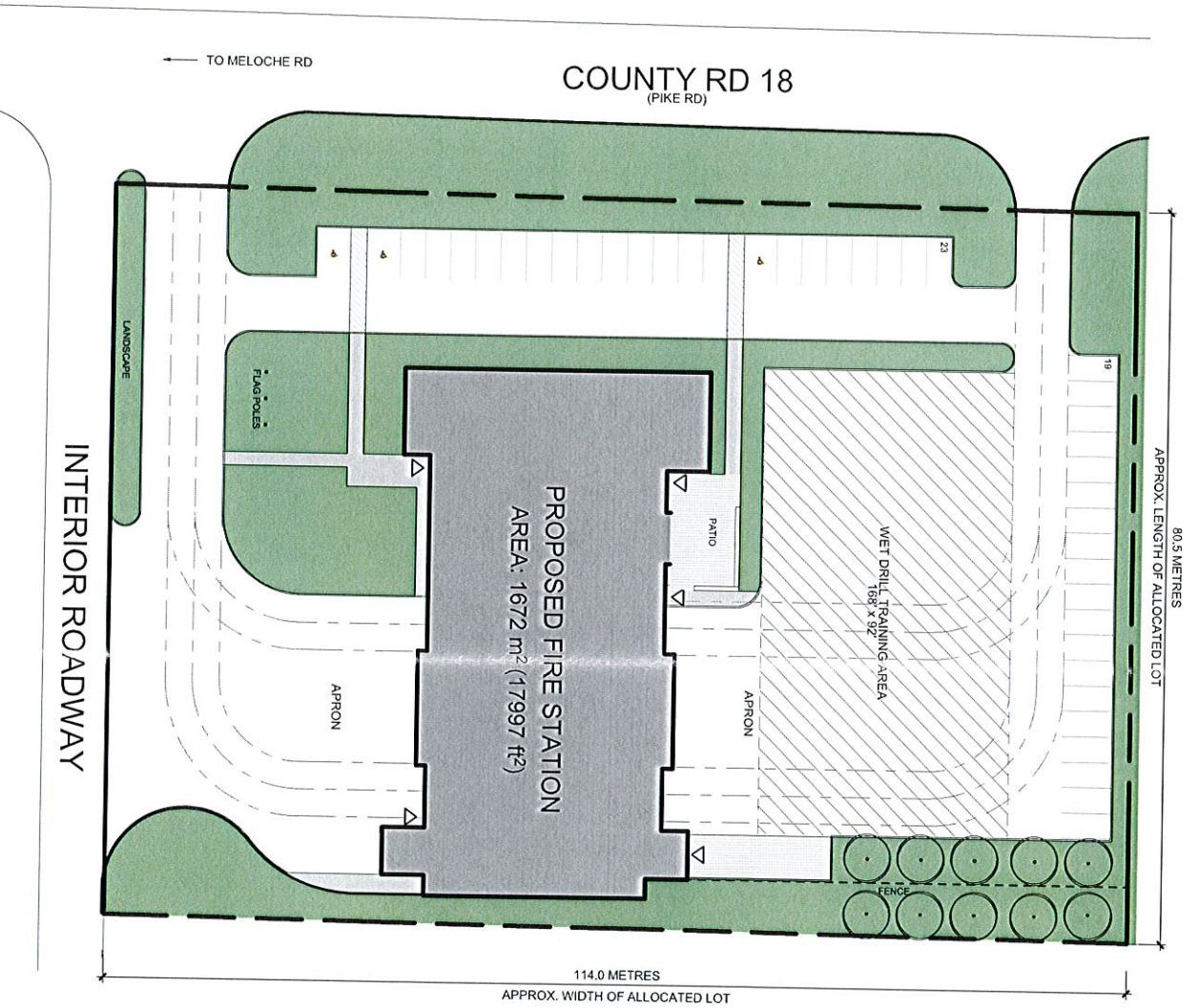

EAST ELEVATION

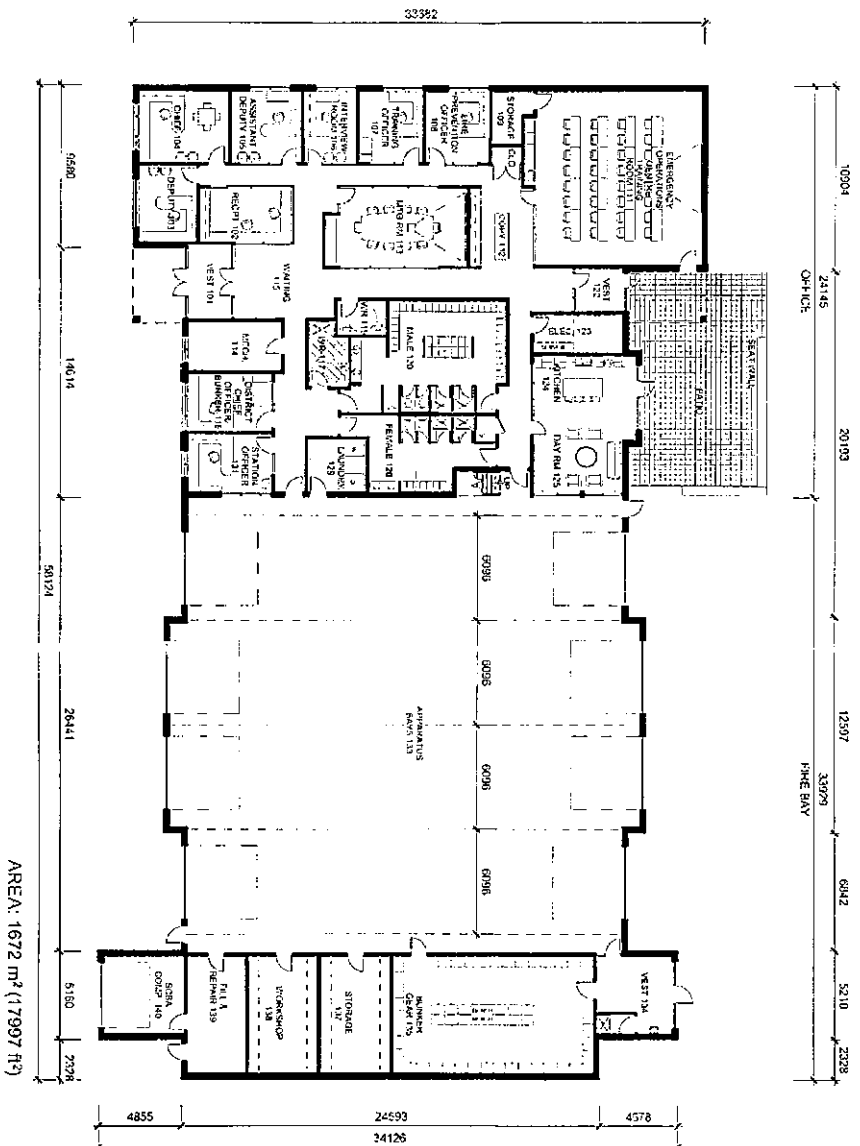

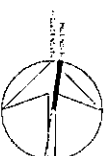




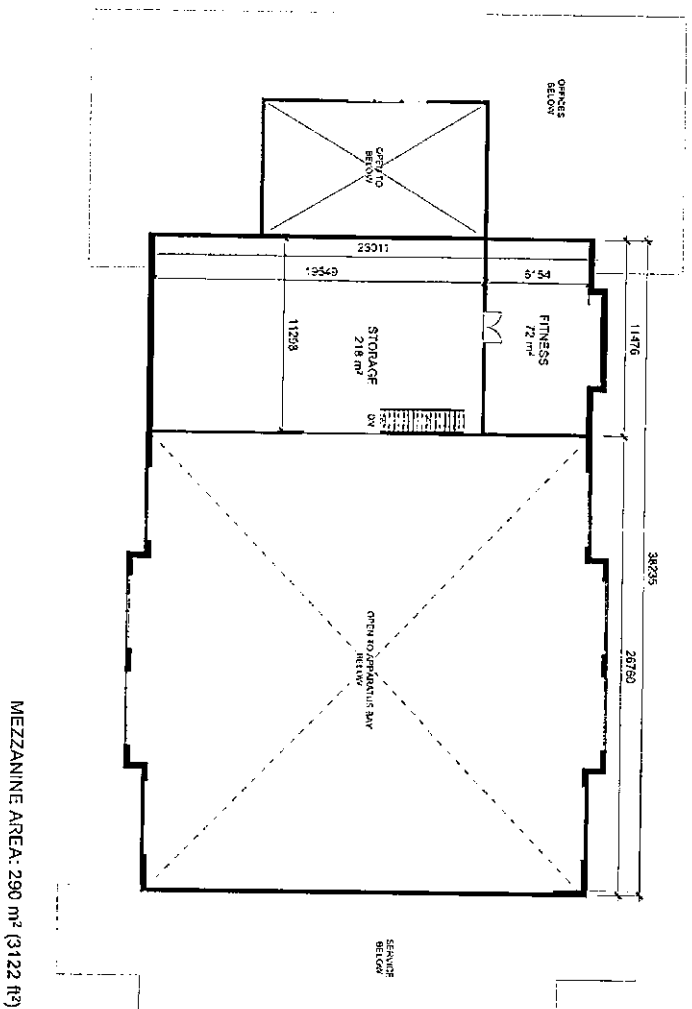
## GROUND FLOOR PLAN

We have engaged a Cost Consultant to prepare a preliminary cost estimate for the proposed fire station based on the conceptual drawings prepared for the building.

A contingency of 15-20% is recommended to be added to the construction Cost Estimate to accommodate for the early stages of design, as well as to address market conditions such as escalation, current inflation, and the volatility of cost of construction materials and supply chain challenges.
