Drama clubs and presentations, school concerts, chess clubs and tournaments, musical shows and presentations, fine arts clubs, computer clubs, stage hands, house league and inter-school teams and team administrators (e.g. managers, time & score keepers etc.)

#### **In the Community:**

Arts and Crafts clubs, horticultural clubs, youth associations, (e.g. cadets, guiding, scouting, youth groups), and sports associations.

## Recreation Leadership Awards

### Criteria for Selection of Recipients

**Note: Not all, but most criteria need to be met.**

The teachers and staff at each elementary school are asked to select one male and one female student who best exemplify the following:

- 1) A student who gives %100 of their energy and ability to recreational activities. They do their best while participating in the endeavours.
- 2) A student who promotes enthusiasm among other students so that the other students in turn can give their most to the activity.
- 3) A student who helps with the “behind the scenes” preparations for the activities. This student may volunteer or be assigned these duties.
- 4) A student who participates readily and generally shows enthusiasm for all activities.
- 5) A student who provides a good role model to younger students.
