Subject: County of Essex Accessibility Fest-for-All

1. RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that:

- The Libro Credit Union Centre location BE NOMINATED for consideration by the County of Essex for hosting the 2025 County of Essex Accessibility Fest-for-All; and
- Administration BE DIRECTED to assist the County of Essex with required elements of planning and hosting the 2025 County of Essex Accessibility Fest-for-All.

2. BACKGROUND:

In 2024, based on the recommendation of the County of Essex Accessibility Advisory Committee, the County of Essex worked with the Town of Essex to host the first Accessibility Fest-for-All at Colchester Harbour to highlight the services and offerings of local agencies, organizations and businesses that seek to improve the access to goods and services for people with disabilities. The Town of Amherstburg participated in the 2024 event.

3. DISCUSSION:

In seeking a location for the 2025 Accessibility Fest-for-All, the Libro Credit Union Centre in the Town of Amherstburg was seen as a potential site and host community. Doing so will allow the Town of Amherstburg to highlight the accessible businesses and services of Amherstburg and the region, including its notable achievement as the first in Canada

to host a Miracle League. The Town's Aphasia Friendly Amherstburg goal will also be something that can be highlighted to those attending, encouraging greater support and adoption of this worthy cause.

The proposal was discussed with the Town's Accessibility Advisory Committee on December 5th, 2024, and the following motion was adopted:

That the Amherstburg Accessibility Advisory Committee ENDORSES the Town of Amherstburg hosting the County of Essex 2025 Accessibility Fest-for-All at the Libro Centre.

Although a date has not been formally adopted yet, as planning continues, the event is expected to take place in September.

4. RISK ANALYSIS:

There is little risk posed to the municipality by this recommendation.

5. FINANCIAL MATTERS:

There are no direct financial implications to the Town of Amherstburg. It should be noted that no fee would be assessed for this undertaking, as it would be considered a Town event utilizing the Libro Centre grounds.

A donor will be sought for some support for a lunch to be provided for the event and any group or individual seeking to offer support for this is encouraged to contact Town Administration.
