CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF AMHERSTBURG BY-LAW NO. 2025-008

By-law to amend Zoning By-law No. 1999-52 6754 County Road 50, Amherstburg

WHEREAS By-law 1999-52, as amended, is a land use control by-law regulating the use of lands and the character, location and use of buildings and structures within the Town of Amherstburg;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Amherstburg deems it appropriate and in the best interest of proper planning to amend By-law 1999-52, as herein provided;

AND WHEREAS this By-law conforms to the Official Plan for the Town of Amherstburg;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Amherstburg enacts as follows:


- 1. THAT Section 17(4)(h) of By-law 1999-52, as amended, is hereby amended by adding the following provisions;
 - "i. Uses Permitted
 - 4. Gas Bar
 - ii. Interior Side Yard Setback
 - 1. The existing setback along the western interior side lot line of 4.94 m shall be maintained.
 - iii. Setback from County Road
 - 1. The existing setback from County Road 50 of 21.88 m from centerline shall be maintained.
 - iv. Parking Minimum
 - 1. 7 parking spaces shall be required for the 185 sq. m. convenience store, 3 parking spaces shall be required for the gas bar and one Type A accessible parking space shall be provided.
 - 2. Notwithstanding the above, should any other use be proposed on the site, or the proposed convenience store be enlarged, parking will be required to be provided as per Section 3.23(c).
- 2. THIS By-law shall take effect from the date of passage by Council and shall come into force in accordance with Sections 34 of the Planning Act, R.S.0. 1990, c.P. 13.

Read a first, second and third time and finally passed this 10th day of February, 2025.
