

#### GENERAL NOTES

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  - 6. ALL WORK PERFORMED SHALL BE IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE HEALTH AND SAFETY ACT LATEST REVISIONS, AS WELL AS THE TOWN OF AMHERSTBURG HEALTH AND SAFETY POLICIES AND PROCEDURES.
  - 1. ALL NEW CONCRETE BARRIER CURBS TO CONFORM WITH THE TOWN OF AMHERSTBURG STANDARDS, AND AS PER DRAWINGS. ALL CONCRETE WORK TO CONFORM WITH THE TOWN OF AMHERSTBURG STANDARDS. ALL SLOPES MUST MEET OR EXCEED TOWN OF AMHERSTBURG FADS AND AODA REGULATIONS.
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- DO NOT WASH OUT CONCRETE TRUCKS NEAR ANY EXISTING CATCH BASINS. A WASHOUT AREA SHALL BE DIRECTED BY THE TOWN PROJECT MANAGER AND ALL HARDENED CONCRETE AND DEBRIS SHALL BE REMOVED AND DISPOSED OF OFF SITE BY THE CONTRACTOR, AT THEIR OWN EXPENSE.

#### EXISTING TREE PROTECTION

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- 13. IF RE-GRADING IS REQUIRED BETWEEN THE DRIP LINE OF AN EXISTING TREE, DO NOT REMOVE OR ADD MORE THAN 100mm (4") OF SOIL. IF THE SITUATION REQUIRES A CHANGE IN GRADE OF MORE THAN 100mm (4") NOTIFY THE TOWN PROJECT MANAGER FOR FURTHER INSTRUCTION.
- 14. DO NOT WRAP OR RIG CABLES AROUND OR IN ANY TREE.
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- 16. WHERE LIMBS OR PORTIONS OF THE TREE AREA TO BE REMOVED AS A RESULT OF CONSTRUCTION WORK, CAREFULLY REMOVE THEM IN ACCORDANCE WITH ACCEPTED ARBORICULTURAL PRACTICE.
- 1. ANY TREES DAMAGED AS A RESULT OF CONSTRUCTION BEYOND REPAIR MUST BE REPLACED TO THE SATISFACTION OF THE TOWN OF AMHERSTBURG, WITH NEW TREES HAVING A CALIPER NO LESS THAN 150mm (6"). THE CONTRACTOR SHALL NOTIFY THE TOWN PROJECT MANAGER AS SOON AS ANY DAMAGE HAS OCCURRED TO ANY EXISTING




