

My name is Deanne Labutte and am writing this letter to you because unfortunately I am unable to attend this meeting, although I will try to zoom in. The reason for this as you know is the building is approximately 14 inches higher than the original 23ft variance. I am not aware if anyone has complained or not so I approached all my surrounding neighbors that the height of the structure would have an impact on and they have signed a paper stating it does not affect them in any way. If this variance is turned down our only other choice is to cut into the engineered trusses and take the roof down 14 inches. I have been told this could very well compromise the integrity of the trusses and leave quite a mess in the newly insulated attic, there is also a roof vent close by which will also cause a larger hole and a considerable amount of money. So I am pleading with you all to please consider the repercussions of this structure if we have to

cut into the roof. Along with this letter should be a copy of the letter from Mr. Avolio (chief building official) insuring it is 14 inches too high aswell as signatures from the surrounding neighbors.
